
While our intention is to adhere to the day-by-day itinerary as printed below, a degree of flexibility is built in. Overnight stops may vary from those suggested.

Arrive in Rio de Janeiro and discover the capital's boutiques, boulevards and beaches such as Ipanema and Copacabana. Sunset in Rio is a spectacular time as the city's residents, the Cariocas, head for the beaches while the mountains cast long shadows under a pink and golden sky.

3 Corcovado and Sugar Loaf Mountains

Reach Corcovado Mountain for spectacular views of the city and Christ the Redeemer. Take a walking tour through the historic streets and ride a cable car up Sugar Loaf Mountain.

Relax on the beautiful beaches of Rio de Janeiro.



₹ 5 Ilha Grande

After breakfast you will drive along the coast to the old port of Angra dos Reis. This area of the Costa Verde is perhaps Brazil's most spectacular stretch of coastline, and the two-hour ferry journey to Ilha Grande gives you time to appreciate the magnificent scenery of mountains, jungle, cliffs, islands, bays and deep oceans. Cars are prohibited on Ilha Grande, so from your arrival at the village of Vila do Abraao, you'll walk to your hotel.



₹ 6 Ilha Grande

Day at leisure. Explore the island's jungle trails and enjoy the deserted beach of Praia Lopes Mendes. Trails lead across the island through thick pristine jungle filled with monkeys, butterflies and birds, and to secluded waterfalls and deserted beaches; Praia Lopes Mendes was voted one of the best in Brazil.



₹ **7** Paraty

Drive along the Costa Verde to Paraty. It's a spectacular route where mountains line the side of the road and green jungle drops directly into the sea. Upon arrival, there's free time to explore.



₹ 8 Paraty

Take a guided walking tour of this 18th century colonial town. Paraty is a Historic National Monument and UNESCO listed; 65% of the town is inside the National Park of Serra da Bocaina. You will visit several churches, the museum, and some of the old houses.



₹ 9 Free day in Paraty

Day at leisure. You could take a boat trip around Paraty's 65 islands; the waters are perfect for swimming and snorkelling.

Food & Drink

Budgeting for your Tour

You will need some extra money to cover meals and drinks not included in the tour price, any optional sightseeing, souvenirs and items of a personal nature such as laundry.

Foreign Exchange

Brazil

Local Currency: Real.

Recommended Currency for Exchange: Carry your funds in US Dollar Travellers Cheques/cash (NOT Sterling, which is almost impossible to change). It is advisable to take a minimum of US\$400-\$500 of your total spending money in cash, in mixed denominations. Notes should be in good condition otherwise they might be difficult to exchange.

Where to Exchange: Your Tour Leader will advise you on arrival. When changing money always keep your receipts for changing back

ATM Availability: Widely spread in all countries. Recommend to use as much as possible. Although always have some cash as back-

Credit Card Acceptance: Credit cards are useful and can be used in many places, but may be subject to a 10% service charge.

Travellers Cheques: Travellers Cheques can be awkward or expensive to change (American Express are the easiest to change).

Joining your Tour

Flight Information

You are able to book this tour on a 'land only' basis or as a 'flight inclusive' package. Your flight inclusive package will be fully protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) ATOL protection scheme.

Booking a land only package with Explore

For passengers making their own travel arrangements, please ensure you join the group as described on day one of the tour itinerary. If you are considering purchasing your own airline tickets, you can book these through any travel agent, directly with an airline or through an online flight consolidator. In all cases, we would be happy to arrange transfers to and from the joining point of your tour if required.

Clients booked on 'Land Only' arrangements should make their own way to the joining point. Please refer to separate 'Joining Instructions' for time and place of rendezvous with tour leader

Booking a flight inclusive package with Explore

We have a huge selection of competitive flights not only from London but from many regional airports around the UK allowing us to compare fares between scheduled carriers as well as low cost and charter airlines. Our dedicated flights team will match the best flight options to your arrival and departure airport to ensure you get the very best priced flight at all times.

On our website we do display a UK flight inclusive package price which is usually based on a London departure. To avoid paying supplements or to secure the best available fare for your preferred flight option, we recommend booking as early as possible, especially for peak travel dates.



Important Information

Travel Insurance

It is a condition of joining any of our tours that you must have valid travel insurance. It must indicate that you have cover for (at least) medical expenses and emergency repatriation in the event of illness or injury. Medical and repatriation insurance cover is not mandatory for UK residents who are travelling in England and Scotland. We also strongly recommend your policy includes curtailment, personal effects and cancellation protection as all deposits paid are non-refundable.

If you require travel insurance for your tour, Explore Worldwide is an appointed representative of Campbell Irvine Limited, who is authorised and regulated by the Financial Services authority. Our travel insurance policy is specially tailored to the needs of the adventure traveller and will cover you for any included activity on any Explore trip. You can either purchase this at the time of booking or call us on 0844 499 0903 after you have booked.

Vaccinations & Protection

Brazil

Nothing compulsory, we recommend protection against malaria, typhoid, tetanus, polio and hepatitis A. Consult your travel clinic for latest advice on different prophylaxis available against malaria. We recommend protection against yellow fever. There have been very few cases reported, but local authorities do recommend travellers get immunised against yellow fever. The above is not an exhaustive list. As befits such a large landmass, there are several distinct regional variations. Rio's and Paraty's average maximum is 25°C May-October, the rains falling December to March. On this tour, rain should be expected at some time - and if travelling in July and August, temperatures will be cool at night in the area around Iguaçu and Curitiba.

Luggage allowance on tour:

Unfortunately it does occasionally happen that luggage does not always reach its destination on the same flight as its owner, or possibly it may be damaged in transit. If you are unlucky enough for this to occur, it is important that you file a PIR (Property Irregularity Report) with the airline before leaving the airport. This is essential when you come to make a claim either against the airline or from your travel insurance company

Booking Your Holiday

Peace of mind - book with confidence

You can book your Explore holiday with confidence, as all monies paid to us for your trip are fully protected. Explore is a fully bonded tour operator licensed by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and by ABTOT.

The air holiday packages (Tours including flights) that we advertise are ATOL protected, since we hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence granted by the Civil Aviation Authority. Our ATOL number is ATOL 2595. In addition, As a member of the Association of Bonded Travel Organisers Trust Limited (ABTOT), Explore has provided a bond to meet the requirements of the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992. Please note that packages booked outside the UK are only protected when purchased directly with Explore.

Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% nonrefundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services. If your travel starts within 60 days of booking, full payment will be required at the time of booking

100% No Surcharge Guarantee

The price paid for our holidays is no longer subject to change. Once booked and confirmed we will guarantee the price you pay will not increase, whatever the circumstances. You will not be approached to pay fuel surcharges unlike the vast majority of other adventure tour operators. The price guarantee applies to all new bookings departing between 1st January 2013 and 31st December 2014.
