# Visit Mljet National Park

After breakfast we cruise on towards the forested island of Mljet, where legend has it Odysseus and the nymph Calypso spent their time together. Mljet National Park covers more than 100 square kilometers and includes two beautiful salt-water lakes, surrounded by lush evergreen forests with several rare varieties of plant life. On an island in the larger lake is the Benedictine St. Mary's Monastery, built in the 12th century, which can be visited by small motor launch and the park has a maze of pathways to explore on foot whilst the clear waters of the lakes offer some welcome opportunities for swimming.

# Discover Korcula Island

This morning we will head to Korcula. Korcula is the most obviously historical of all of the Dalmatian islands and is believed to be the birthplace of Marco Polo, as well as being well known for its high quality white wine production. Korcula is undoubtedly one of the highlights of the trip. Take a self-guided walking tour of Korcula Town whose history, like most of Croatia, spans the centuries. Start your walk at the Rector' s Place, with its admirable 15th Century turrets, and continue to the City Museum housed in a 16th Century mansion. Here you can witness an impressive array of artefacts and Byzantine icons that bring Korcula's history to life. Korcula is a photographers dream, with its red terracotta roofs, stone cathedrals and winding roads. You may choose to take dinner at a typical Mediterranean restaurant with fresh seafood prepared and served as a local speciality.

# Explore Hvar Island

Today we explore the sunniest of the 1244 Croatian islands, Hvar and head for its jewel, the ancient town of Hvar. 7000 years of history are encapsulated in this small island town. Sparkling amid green hills, rocky terrain and a sea of cobalt blue, Hvar is a producer of olive oil, lavender oil and local wine. The town is filled with sophisticated shops, cafes and restaurants. There is a main square around which most of the activity revolves. Walk through the narrow streets to visit the 15th Century Franciscan Monastery; the renaissance cloister, the old rectory that today houses a collection of lace, manuscripts and books; and the church with its remarkable collection of paintings. Wander to the main square to see St. Stephen' s Cathedral with its treasury and bell tower, all of which bear the mark of Venetian rule. You can climb up the fortress and enjoy the sunset tonight.

#### Visit Sipan Island

Cruise to the largest and least-visited of the Elaphiti Islands; Sipan is a delightful mix of olive trees, vines and craggy peaks and dotted with remnants from the Roman times. On arrival we will take to the saddle to enjoy a quiet ride across the island to the northern settlement of Sipanska Luka, exploring the pretty olive groves and ancient vineyards on the way.

# Cruise to Dubrovnik; explore the town

This morning we will take to the water with a guided sea-kayaking trip through the clear blue waters of the Adriatic. With full equipment and instruction provided, we spend the morning paddling below the towering city walls of this majestic town. Then we will have the opportunity to explore them and its twisting alleyways by foot. Now essentially fully restored following damage from shelling in the Siege of Dubrovnik in 1991-92, the old medieval town of Dubrovnik still retains its unique atmosphere and charm. UNESCO have granted Dubrovnik World Cultural Heritage Status as one of the world's finest examples of a fortified medieval town. 'Those who seek paradise on earth', George Bernard Shaw once wrote, should come to Dubrovnik. The best way to get a feel of the layout of the



old town and its wealth of monasteries, museums and old buildings is on our guided tour of the main places of interest. Starting from Pile Gate we will visit the Franciscan Monastery, Dominican Monastery, the cathedral and the Rector's Palace. There will also be time for you to walk the entire circumference of the city wall (1940m) for great views over the twisting alleyways and out over the Adriatic (optional).

Local Currency: Croatian Kuna.

#### **Flight Information**

You are able to book this tour on a 'land only' basis or as a 'flight inclusive' package. Your flight inclusive package will be fully protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) ATOL protection scheme.

If you are considering purchasing your own airline tickets, you can book these through any travel agent, directly with an airline or through an online flight consolidator. # **Important Information**

#### **Travel Insurance**

It is a condition of joining any of our tours that you must have valid travel insurance. It must indicate that you have cover for (at least) medical expenses and emergency repatriation in the event of illness or injury. Medical and repatriation insurance cover is not mandatory for UK residents who are travelling in England and Scotland. We also strongly recommend your policy includes curtailment, personal effects and cancellation protection as all deposits paid are non-refundable.

If you require travel insurance for your tour, Explore Worldwide is an appointed representative of Campbell Irvine Limited, who is authorised and regulated by the Financial Services authority. Our travel insurance policy is specially tailored to the needs of the adventure traveller and will cover you for any included activity on any Explore trip. You can either purchase this at the time of booking or call us on 0844 499 0903 after you have booked.

#### Visa Information

Croatia: Visas are not required by UK, Australian, New Zealand, US or Canadian citizens. Other nationalities should consult their local embassy or consular office.

All visa information is subject to change. You should confirm all visa related questions with the relevant Embassy prior to departure.

#### **Vaccinations & Protection**

#### **Croatia**

Nothing compulsory, but we recommend protection against hepatitis A, polio, tetanus, and typhoid. Tick-borne encephalitis is recommended by some medical sources if travelling in certain areas of Eastern Europe, at specific times of the year. Check latest requirements with your travel clinic or doctor prior to departure. The above is not an exhaustive list. Visa and vaccination requirements are subject to change and should be confirmed before departure.

# Climate

# Croatia

The Croatian Adriatic has a Mediterranean climate with mild winters and warm, sunny summers. There is a chance of sporadic rain in spring and autumn, though generally it is in the form of short showers. Thunderstorms occur in summer, generally helping to cool the air. Occasional high winds may make the more open waters too choppy for comfortable passage and the itinerary will need to be adapted accordingly. #### **Footwear**

Comfortable shoes/trainers plus sandals for relaxing. Footwear is generally not worn on board, but you may find a pair of old shoes or plastic sandals useful to avoid sea urchins on rocks.

#### Clothing

July and August are the hottest months, but early and late in the season go prepared with clothing to suit drops in temperature and the showers. You'll need your swimming gear, a 'bath' towel (as towels are not provided on board) and a beach towel. Take a fleece for potential chilly breezes when sailing.

#### **Equipment**

We also recommend a water bottle, a sun hat, sunglasses and sun cream, a towel and if you wish to snorkel, your own mask and snorkel. Please note that if you wish to sleep out on deck on some nights, as many choose to do in good weather, you should bring a sheet sleeping bag and a roll mat, as the cabin bedding is not permitted on deck. You may also wish to bring ear plugs.



#### Luggage: On Tour

One main piece of baggage and a daypack for shore excursions. Remember that you will have to carry your own luggage - so don't overload yourself. Space is limited on board so only bring what you need. A soft bag is more easily stored on board than a hard suitcase.

#### Peace of mind - book with confidence

You can book your Explore holiday with confidence, as all monies paid to us for your trip are fully protected. Explore is a fully bonded tour operator licensed by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and by ABTOT.

The air holiday packages (Tours including flights) that we advertise are ATOL protected, since we hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence granted by the Civil Aviation Authority. Our ATOL number is ATOL 2595. In addition, As a member of the Association of Bonded Travel Organisers Trust Limited (ABTOT), Explore has provided a bond to meet the requirements of the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992. Please note that packages booked outside the UK are only protected when purchased directly with Explore.

#### Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% nonrefundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services. If your travel starts within 60 days of booking, full payment will be required at the time of booking
