DAY 1 Overnight flight to Thailand

Depart the UK on your overnight flight to Bangkok.

Why Book this trip?

Although the climate varies within the country, Thailand is a good year round destination. For the bulk of the country the months from November to April offer pleasantly cool, dry conditions making it perfect for travel. On the southern peninsula the climate differs between the east and west coast. East coast beaches receive their warmest temperatures during our summer months, whilst the west coast enjoys their warm, dry conditions during our winter and spring.

DAY **2** Arrive in Bangkok

Upon arrival in Bangkok, you will be transferred to your hotel and have free time to relax and explore this afternoon.

DAY **3** Bangkok city tour by long-tail boat

Today you have a tour of Thailand's capital, including a visit to the Grand Palace and Temple of the Emerald Buddha. This large complex is home to over 100 ornate and colourful stupas and temples; the King still resides in the adjoining palace. You'll then continue to Wat Pho and visit the huge 16th century Reclining Buddha. Part of the temple compound is a Thai Traditional Massage School, the first temple teaching massage, and you'll have the opportunity to have a short visit. Your tour continues through the local market to the Chao Phya River, where you have a long-tail boat trip, the perfect way to relax and see everyday life along the riverbanks.

DAY **4** Overnight train to Surat Thani

This morning is free to explore the city a little further. You may wish to ask your Tailormade Regional Specialist to arrange a visit to Jim Thompson's House. The beautiful teak buildings are home to the textile designer's huge collection of south-east Asian art. Or why not take the sky train to Bangkok's huge Chatuchak Weekend market, where over 15,000 stalls sell everything from clothes to home ware, food to tribal handicrafts and much more. This evening board your overnight train for your journey south to Surat Thani.

DAY **5** Khao Sok National Park

You arrive into Surat Thani early this morning and head inland to Khao Sok National Park. A three-hour walk takes you through the jungle, to hidden waterfalls and refreshing swimming spots. You'll then meet your elephant and enjoy a ride deeper into the jungle. Spend the evening relaxing at your lodge, listening to the jungle sounds and looking out for bats and fireflies.

DAY **6** Khao Sok National Park

Today is yours to discover Khao Sok National Park. First, you'll head off by long-tail boat to enjoy tranquil Chiew Lan Lake, surrounded by mountains. Next, continue to your jungle rafterhouse, from where you can get close to nature by exploring by sea kayak in the coves around your accommodation.

DAY **7** Continue to Krabi

Departing the jungle this morning you will be driven to Krabi on the southern coast where limestone karsts jut from the mangroves, and secluded coves hide pristine beaches. This afternoon has been left free for you to explore at your leisure.

DAY **8** Krabi

Today is a free day to relax and enjoy your idyllic surroundings, whether it's the golden beaches, swimming pool or a delicious seafood barbecue for lunch.

DAY 9 Sea kayaking

Today is at leisure, you may choose to explore the mangrove forests, lagoons and islands around Krabi from your kayak. Alternatively ask your Tailormade Regional Specialist to book a day trip to Koh Phi Phi where you can swim with colourful fish at Lohsamah and Monkey Bay, snorkel among coral gardens and laze on white sand beaches at Maya Bay.

Enjoy your last moments at the beach, before flying back to Bangkok.

You can book your Explore holiday with confidence, as all monies paid to us for your trip are fully protected. Explore is a fully bonded tour operator licensed by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and by ABTOT.

The air holiday packages (Tours including flights) that we advertise are ATOL protected, since we hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence granted by the Civil Aviation Authority. Our ATOL number is ATOL 2595. In addition, As a member of the Association of Bonded Travel Organisers Trust Limited (ABTOT), Explore has provided a bond to meet the requirements of the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992. Please note that packages booked outside the UK are only protected when purchased directly with Explore.

Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

For Self-Guided holidays and Private Journeys simply choose your date of travel and let us know so we can confirm all ground services.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% non-refundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services. If your travel starts within 60 days of booking, full payment will be required at the time of booking

100% No Surcharge Guarantee

The price paid for our holidays is no longer subject to change. Once booked and confirmed we will guarantee the price you pay will not increase, whatever the circumstances. You will not be approached to pay fuel surcharges unlike the vast majority of other adventure tour operators.
