DAY 1 Fly to Entebbe

Depart the UK on a flight to Entebbe, Uganda.

Why Book this trip?

Uganda is sunny most of the year with temperatures usually remaining comfortable & rarely exceeding 30 degrees. Just like its African neighbours, Uganda follows a similar pattern with two wet seasons during the year. The main rainy season falls between late March and May with rain often lasting days, thus making travel difficult. The light rainy season is during November when it generally lasts only an hour or two each day leaving conditions revitalised and refreshed.

DAY 2 Journey to Kampala

On arrival at Entebbe, you will be met and transferred to your chosen hotel in the capital city Kampala.

DAY 3 Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary and Murchison Falls National Park

This morning you depart Kampala and head north to one of the most beautiful protected areas in Uganda, Murchison Falls National Park. En route you will stop at Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary. Located within 70 square kilometres of pristine bush country and open savannah the Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary runs a breeding program, nine calves have been born to date, and released into the park. Rangers protect these magnificent animals day and night, the only place to see wild rhinoceros in Uganda, this is a very important sanctuary for their future. After lunch your journey continues to Murchison Falls National Park.

DAY 4 Murchison Falls National Park

Uganda's largest and oldest national park, Murchison Falls National Park's palm studded grassland supports dense populations of wildlife, including lions, hippos, giraffes and buffalo. The park is one of the few places in Uganda to see the shoebill stork among its 450 bird species recorded. The Victoria Nile runs through the centre of the park and plunges 45m over the rift valley wall creating the magnificent Murchison Falls. After an early morning breakfast, head out on a game drive where you may see elephants, giraffes, lions, hartebeests and a huge variety of birds. After lunch you take a boat journey on the Nile for game-viewing at close quarters.

DAY 5 Kabwoya Game Reserve

Time to relax this morning and enjoy a final game drive in Murchison Falls National Park, before heading to Kabowya Game Reserve. Beautifully located on Lake Albert, Kabowya Game Reserve is the newest of Uganda's wildlife reserves, previously it was a controlled hunting area however numbers of game are now increasing. Enjoy game drives or walks in the open plains to see kob, warthog, bushbuck and buffalo.

DAY 6 Kibale Forest National Park

Today you visit a fishing village, giving you a great opportunity to meet local communities and learn about their way-of-life. Following your visit your journey continues south to Kibale Forest National Park. Home to the greatest variety and concentration of primates in East Africa, including over 1,000 chimpanzees, Kibale Forest National Park is also host to some 375 bird species. You may be lucky enough to spot some of the amazing wildlife en route to your lodge.

DAY 7 Chimpanzee tracking and Bigodi Swamp

Today the forest opens its doors for sensational chimp tracking. Kibale Forest is reputable for having the greatest variety and highest concentration of primates in East Africa. Enjoy a guided nature walk in the tropical rainforest in search of the wild chimpanzee, redtailed monkey, black and white colobus monkey and many others. After lunch, transfer to Bigodi for a completely different walk. Here you will join a guided Swamp Walk through the Wetland Sanctuary, which is famous for the many birds and primates that live in this area.

DAY 8 Journey to Queen Elizabeth National Park

Leave Kibale and head for the vast savannah plains of Queen Elizabeth National Park. As you leave Kibale you will pass rolling hills of tea plantations, the journey becomes even more stunning as you near Queen Elizabeth National Park and drive past the scenic crater

lakes. Enjoy a game drive en route to your camp, you may be lucky enough to spot some of the big game or bird species that reside in the park.

DAY 9 Game drives in Queen Elizabeth National Park

The scenic splendor of Queen Elizabeth National Park, with the Rwenzori Mountains in the background, offers a perfect setting to your African wildlife adventure. This morning you head out on safari in search of lion, elephant, buffalo and other animals in their natural habitat before returning to camp in time for lunch. In the afternoon you take a boat cruise along the Kazinga Channel, a natural channel between Lake Edward and Lake George. Thanks to the abundant birdlife as well as the herds of elephants, buffaloes and hundreds of hippos that are cooling off at the shores, this cruise will be one of the highlights of your trip.

DAY 10 Journey to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

This morning has been left free, you may wish to relax at your hotel, choose to go for another game drive or hike in the Kyambura Wildlife Reserve in search of the chimpanzees (not included). It is a beautiful walk through the river valley, completely covered with tropical rainforest. In the afternoon you continue to Bwindi, home of the endangered mountain gorillas.

DAY 11 Gorilla trekking

Today you'll experience what some people define a life changing event: a meeting with the gentle giants of Bwindi! Expect to walk a long distance in steep and muddy conditions, sometimes with rain overhead, before you encounter any gorillas. But it will definitely be worthwhile as you observe them closely while they eat, play and rest, a unique and unforgettable experience! Unfortunately, Mountain gorillas (as opposed to Lowland gorillas) are one of the world's most endangered species so the entrance and gorilla tracking fees revenue generated from tourism in protected parks such as Bwindi, offer them their only chance of survival. Distinct from their cousins who live in the open spaces and lowland forests of West Africa, Mountain gorillas are found at an altitude of between 1520m and 3650m. Gentle giants and vegetarians, they are normally peaceful unless provoked. Our groups have been rewarded with the thrill of very close encounters.

DAY 12 Journey to Lake Mburu

From Lake Bunyoni drive to Lake Mburu National Park. Home to a good population of game, including zebras, buffaloes and antelopes, the national park is relatively small in comparison to some of its counterparts. Lake Mburu is one of five lakes within the park, perfect for spotting hippopotamus cooling-off in the water, kingfishers and fish eagles. The national park is home to 350 bird species including shoebill, turaco and hoopoe among others. This afternoon is your first wildlife safari experience, with either a game drive or boat ride on the lake.

DAY 13 Game drive in Lake Mburu National Park

Lake Mburu National Park is renowned for its rich birdlife and beautiful lakes. On your final day on safari, enjoy a nature walk searching for zebra, warthog, buffalo, impala and, if you're lucky, see the largest of Africa's antelope - the beautiful eland. This afternoon transfer back to Kampala, stopping en route at the equator.

DAY 14 Journey to Entebbe

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast before heading back to Entebbe in time for your return flight home.

Recommended Currency for Exchange: You should take the majority of your spending money in US Dollars cash some of which to change into Ugandan Shillings. Please be aware that notes issued pre- 2006, or are not the "Big Face" kind, are not normally accepted in East Africa at all. Take mixed denomination bills in good condition and note that higher Ugandan Shilling rates are available for larger (\$50- \$100) US Dollar bills. Dirty and torn US Dollar notes are NOT accepted at all in Uganda. GBP Sterling is easily exchanged in Kampala only.

Flight Information

You are able to book this tour on a 'land only' basis or as a 'flight inclusive' package. Your flight inclusive package will be fully protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) ATOL protection scheme.

Booking a land only package with Explore

Joining Tour Abroad

Customers booked on the 'Land Only' arrangements will now receive a Free Transfer, provided you arrive and depart on the tour only itinerary start and end dates. The transfers will be from the Explore designated airport or train station to the joining point of your tour, and then back from the ending point to the designated airport or train station. The exception to this rule is customers who are booked on a tour where the joining and ending point is at the designated airport or train station.

Free transfers are not available for Self-Guided, Tailormade or Tours for Churches customers.

If you are not eligible for the Free Transfer then you will need to make your own way through to the joining and ending point. On a majority of our tours Explore will be able to provide a private transfer at an additional cost. Please ask for a quote at the time of booking.

Preparing for your Trip

Climate

Uganda

Although conditions are tropical, hot and humid in the centre and west, the rest of Uganda has a pleasant and comfortable climate. The dry season is generally from December to early March and June to the end of August/early September. Temperature can vary from around 28°C during the day to 12°C in the evening. High mountain areas become much cooler at night. Most of Uganda experiences a double rainy season. Rainfall is moderate, only exceeding 1250mm a year in the higher areas. But it may rain at any time of the year, particularly in equatorial rainforest such as Bwindi. Lake Victoria influences the local weather patterns considerably and ensures the surrounding region is wetter than elsewhere. Luggage allowance on trip:

Unfortunately it does occasionally happen that luggage does not always reach its destination on the same flight as its owner, or possibly it may be damaged in transit. Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

For Self-Guided holidays and Private Journeys simply choose your date of travel and let us know so we can confirm all ground services.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% non-refundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services.
