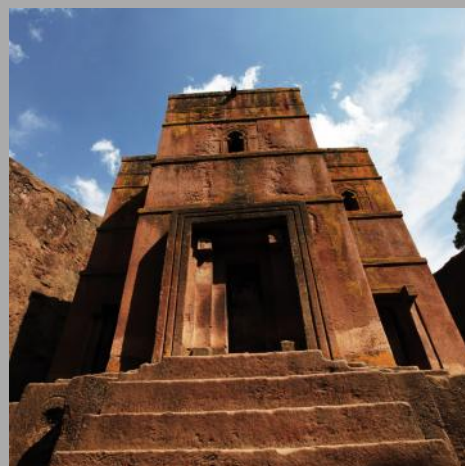

DAY 2 Arrival in Addis Ababa

Arrive into Addis Ababa where you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Depending on your arrival time, why not join a guided tour for a glimpse of the diverse lifestyles and cultures exhibited within this modern city.

DAY 3 Axum

An early morning flight brings you to Axum, the ancient capital of the Aksumite Kingdom and one of the holiest cities in Ethiopia. Pre-dating the arrival of Christianity in Africa, its intricately carved granite obelisks (stelae) are thought to be funeral monuments for its ancient rulers. Today it is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Spend the afternoon exploring this fascinating town.

DAY 4 Lalibela

Fly to Lalibela, one of the greatest religious sites of the Christian world and arguably Ethiopia's most famous sacred place of worship. The small town of Lalibela is situated high in the Lasta Mountains at over 8,500 ft above sea level. This afternoon, start your exploration of the Lalibela's churches and discover some of the country's oldest religious churches, amazing frescos and elaborately carved stonework. The first group of churches you visit are said to represent "earthly" Jerusalem. Many religious festivals and ceremonies take place here, so why not try and coincide your visit with one of these?

DAY 5 Carved churches of Lalibela

This morning, rise early and journey out of Lalibela to Asheten Mariam. Located atop a mountain overlooking Lalibela you'll take a mule to the top of the mountain where the views are very impressive; it's easy to understand why the priests at this church believe they are the "closest to God". This afternoon, visit the second group of churches said to represent "heavenly" Jerusalem, including the cross-shaped Bete Giorgis, St. George Church.

DAY 6 Yimrehane Christos cave church

Today you drive out of Lalibela to the foothills of the Lasta Massif where you find Yimrehane Christos. This magnificent church is built within a cave in Mount Abuna Yosef. The walls of this cave church are covered in murals and are thought to be some of the oldest surviving paintings in Ethiopia.

DAY 7 Simien Mountains

Fly to Gondar and take an afternoon walk in the stunning Simien Mountains National Park. Enjoy the isolation and tranquility of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its breathtaking scenery and distinct wildlife. Look out for the endemic walia ibex, gelada baboon and the rare Ethiopian wolf.

DAY 8 Gondar

This morning you journey back to Gondar, known as Africa's Camelot. Admire the beautiful architecture of the town's many palaces and castles, with their 17th century Spanish and Portuguese influences. Visit the Debre Birhan Selassie Church, one of Ethiopia's most important churches, famed for its beautiful cherubic paintings and colourful murals.

DAY 9 Journey to Bahir Dar

A three hour drive brings you to the attractive town of Bahir Dar on the shores of Lake Tana, Ethiopia's largest lake. In the afternoon take a boat trip on the lake, discovering the many islands which are home to beautiful monasteries and a variety of bird species.

DAY 10 Visit to the Blue Nile Falls

Spend the morning at the spectacular Tissat Falls (Blue Nile Falls) where the Blue Nile River cascades down 45m on the start of its 1,000 mile journey downstream to Khartoum. Enjoy the colourful birdlife and lush scenery before flying to Addis Ababa for your final evening.

Recommended Currency for Exchange: It is advisable to take your spending money in Sterling, Euros or US Dollars cash (high denomination notes usually get better exchange rates). Please note that any pre- 1999 or torn US Dollar bills will not be accepted in Ethiopia. Please keep any receipts as you may be able to change back any unused local currency.

Flight Information

You are able to book this tour on a 'land only' basis or as a 'flight inclusive' package. Your flight inclusive package will be fully protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) ATOL protection scheme.

Booking a land only package with Explore

For passengers making their own travel arrangements, please ensure you join the group as described on day one of the tour itinerary. If you are considering purchasing your own airline tickets, you can book these through any travel agent, directly with an airline or through an online flight consolidator. In all cases, we would be happy to arrange transfers to and from the joining point of your tour if required.

Booking a flight inclusive package with Explore

We have a good selection of flights not only from London but from many regional airports around the UK allowing us to compare fares between scheduled carriers as well as low cost and charter airlines. Our dedicated flights team will match the best flight options to your arrival and departure airport.

On our website we display a UK flight inclusive package guide price which is generally based on a London departure. To avoid paying supplements or to secure your preferred flight option, we recommend booking as early as possible, especially for peak travel dates.

Important Information

Travel Insurance

It is a condition of joining **any** of our tours that you must have valid travel insurance. It must indicate that you have cover for (at least) medical expenses and emergency repatriation in the event of illness or injury. Medical and repatriation insurance cover is not mandatory for UK residents who are travelling in England and Scotland. We also strongly recommend your policy includes curtailment, personal effects and cancellation protection as all deposits paid are non-refundable. You will also need to ensure your travel policy covers you for all activities you intend to do whilst on tour. Your insurer may charge an additional premium for certain activities.

If you require travel insurance for your tour, Explore Worldwide is an appointed representative of Campbell Irvine Limited, who is authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority. Our travel insurance policy is specially tailored to the needs of the adventure traveller and will cover you for any included activity on any Explore trip. You can either purchase this at the time of booking or call us on 0844 499 0903 after you have booked.

Vaccinations & Protection

Ethiopia

An International Certificate of Vaccination against yellow fever is required. We recommend protection against malaria, hepatitis A, diphtheria, tetanus, typhoid and polio. Although the risk is low you may also consider immunisation against rabies and meningococcal meningitis. Consult your travel clinic for latest advice on different prophylaxis available against Malaria. The above is not an exhaustive list. Visa and vaccination requirements are subject to change and should be confirmed before departure.

Preparing for your Tour

Climate

Ethiopia

Ethiopia is generally pleasant and warm, but varies with altitude. The long rains usually arrive mid- June to early September and the short rains between mid-February and April although this pattern has been completely erratic in recent times. After the rains, the highlands of northern Ethiopia are usually green and thus particularly scenic. The temperature all year round rarely falls below 18°C. Night-time temperatures in the mountains can be cold and can drop below freezing at higher altitude. There is a strong risk of sunburn at high altitude in Ethiopia. Luggage allowance on tour:

Unfortunately it does occasionally happen that luggage does not always reach its destination on the same flight as its owner, or possibly it may be damaged in transit. If you are unlucky enough for this to occur, it is important that you file a PIR (Property Irregularity Report) with the airline before leaving the airport. This is essential when you come to make a claim either against the airline or from your travel insurance company

You can book your Explore holiday with confidence, as all monies paid to us for your trip are fully protected. Explore is a fully bonded tour operator licensed by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and by ABTOT.

The air holiday packages (Tours including flights) that we advertise are ATOL protected, since we hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence granted by the Civil Aviation Authority. Our ATOL number is ATOL 2595. In addition, As a member of the Association of Bonded Travel Organisers Trust Limited (ABTOT), Explore has provided a bond to meet the requirements of the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992. Please note that packages booked outside the UK are only protected when purchased directly with Explore.

Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% non-refundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services. If your travel starts within 60 days of booking, full payment will be required at the time of booking

100% No Surcharge Guarantee

The price paid for our holidays is no longer subject to change. Once booked and confirmed we will guarantee the price you pay will not increase, whatever the circumstances. You will not be approached to pay fuel surcharges unlike the vast majority of other adventure tour operators.
