## Bay Of Naples and The Amalfi Coast

Exploring the beautiful Amalfi Coast and the Bay of Naples, this trip takes in the well-preserved Roman ruins of Pompeii and Herculaneum and the Greek temples of Paestum. We spend time exploring the atmospheric streets of Naples' old quarter, go underground in the fascinating Napoli Sotterranea and discover a wealth of Roman artefacts at its prestigious museum. We also explore iconic Capri, the Amalfi Coast and Sorrento and have the chance to climb to the crater rim of Mount Vesuvius.

### Why Book this trip

On this trip we explore all the best known highlights plus lesser known attractions of the region and we include more than most other operators do. We include a visit to the beautiful island of Capri which is a must for any visitor to Sorrento - this is charged at an additional cost by most other tour operators. We stay within a few hundred metres of the historic site at Pompeii allowing you to spend ample time at this famed attraction and to get there before the crowds. We also visit the lesser-known, but fascinating underground area of Naples Sotterranea as well as the world renowned National Museum.



### Suitability

We've given each of our tours a comfort rating and a tour pace, walking or cycling grade to give you a general idea about the level of activity on each tour and the standard of accommodation you will be staying in at the end of your day's adventure.

### DAY 1 Join trip in Naples

Our trip starts in Naples, a city of diverse contrasts and one that evokes fierce pride among the locals. Its rich history, staunch Catholicism and exasperating charm make it one of the most engaging cities in the country. Our hotel is set upon a hilltop and has its own botanical garden, which offers fantastic panoramic views of the city and Gulf of Naples below. It's a lovely spot for you to relax this evening.

### DAY 2 Visit to the National Museum and Napoli Sotterranea

We start our sightseeing this morning with a visit to the National Museum, one of the most important archaeological museums in mainland Europe, which houses a prestigious collection of ancient art. Here, we will see antique marbles, bronze sculptures, beautiful mosaics and a myriad of treasures from the famous sites of Pompeii and Herculaneum, including poignant everyday household items. Other pieces of note include the mosaic of Alexander the Great defeating the Persians at the Battle of Issus and the colossal Farnese Bull, believed to be the largest piece of sculpture from antiquity ever discovered. After visiting the museum, we head underground in the Napoli Sotterranea. 40 metres below Naples' historic centre we'll discover an underground world of passageways that were created in the construction of the city above. The Greeks quarried out the tufa stone and used it to build the city walls and temples and the underground passages were then used as tombs. During the Roman's rein the tunnels were a bypass to avoid climbing Mount Piedi Grotta, then in the early 1990's they were used to transport water through the city and most recently during World War II they became bomb shelters. This afternoon is the turn of old Naples above ground, as we enjoy a walking tour with our Explore Leader of the city. Exploring the old city streets, open air markets and narrow alleyways provides a captivating insight into the city's beating heart, probably unchanged in essence for generations. Following our tour we'll drive to our hotel at Pompeii, which is located just 300 metres from the archaeological site and 100 metres from the Sanctuary of Pompeii. Here you might like to try a glass of Lacryma Christi wine which is produced from grapes grown on the slopes of Mount Vesuvius.

### DAY 3 Chance to climb Mount Vesuvius; visit Herculaneum

This morning there's the opportunity to take the public bus to Mount Vesuvius and walk up to the rim of the volcanic crater, from where there are remarkable views down to Naples, the coastal plain and the glistening bay. Vesuvius is the only active volcano on the European mainland and dominates the skyline between Naples and Pompeii, rising up from the flat, fertile landscape. Since the mighty eruption of AD 79, it has had another 18 violent eruptions. The last one, in 1944, surprised the Allied forces and destroyed an entire squadron of 88 B-25 bombers belonging to the American Air Force. Descending back along a well-graded cinder track, we return to our hotel by public transport. This afternoon we drive to the nearby ruins of Herculaneum at the foot of the western slopes of the volcano. Buried by the Vesuvius eruption of AD 79, the city was hermetically sealed under a thick layer of volcanic mud, which preserved a staggering amount of wooden furniture and other organic materials - even fruit. After our two hour guided tour, you'll have a further hour to explore before we return to our hotel.

## DAY 4 Visit to famed Pompeii, pasta tasting and Sorrento walking tour

Our first stop today is at Pompeii for a guided walking tour to introduce us to this remarkably well-preserved example of a provincial Roman city. The town once housed 15,000 people and was an important commercial centre, as well as a favourite residence of wealthy Roman patricians. Of course, on one fateful day some 2,000 years ago, this all changed when the powerful eruption of nearby Mount Vesuvius buried the city, preserving the town and its citizens in layers of ash and pumice. On our tour, we will see the extensive colonnaded forum with its Temple of Jupiter and the magnificently-decorated villas, such as that of the Vetii. Human casts of some of the victims trapped by the eruption give an emotive snapshot of this catastrophic event. After our visit we'll drive to La Fabbrica Della Pasta for a guided tour of this pasta making factory followed by a pasta tasting lunch accompanied by a glass of local wine. After we've filled up on this freshly made Italian staple we'll drive on to Sorrento. It's a small town with a lot to offer and on arrival we'll take a walking tour of the main highlights followed by free time for you to enjoy dinner. Sorrento's baroque church of Saint Francesco with its cloisters and monastery is worth a visit, especially as it boasts a garden terrace with sweeping views over the Bay of Naples. The historic centre and Piazza Tasso (Central Square) is host to many beautiful shops featuring the work of the local artisans and also restaurants to sample the home-grown cuisine in. The city is rich in historical and religious places of interest, including the remaining four gates of the old city walls. Our hotel is located near to the seafront and a short walk from Sorrento's Central Square.

## DAY 5 Full day trip to the beautiful island of Capri

This morning we transfer to the Port of Sorrento and take the hydrofoil across the Gulf of Naples to the beautiful and popular island of Capri. There are multiple ways to explore the island, such as enjoying a boat trip to the famous Blue Grotto; visit the delightful museum and gardens of Villa San Michele or walk to the Villa Jovis - the ruins of the Roman Emperor Tiberius' cliff top palace with impressive views over the island and the Bay of Naples. More fantastic vistas are afforded from the top of Mount Solaro, which can be reached by chairlift. Following ample time to explore we return to Sorrento by hydrofoil and transfer back to our hotel.

## DAY 6 Drive along the scenic Amalfi Coastal Road to Maiori

Today we leave Sorrento and make our way across the mountainous Sorrento Peninsula to the Amalfi Coast. The coastal road is one of the most famous drives in the world and we get to enjoy the spectacular scenery on our way to Maiori. Along the way we'll stop in town of Amalfi for an orientation tour with our Explore Leader. A great maritime power since the Byzantine era, Amalfi went on to reach its pinnacle during the Middle Ages, when it was an independent trading republic rivalling those of Venice, Pisa and Genoa. The beautiful 11th century Cathedral of Saint Andrea dominates the town - a magnificent combination of Romanesque and Saracen design, with an impressive set of bronze doors that hail from Constantinople. At the far end of the town lies the Valley of the Mills, a once important centre of Amalfi's paper industry, that today echoes with the ghosts of its past glories. You'll then have the option of visiting nearby Ravello or to enjoy some free time in Amalfi to perhaps take a scenic walk or enjoy a delicious gelato. Ravello is a tranquil spot located high on a rocky promontory overlooking the azure waters off the coast. A glorious mix of Moorish flair and aristocratic excess, the town's captivating charms have attracted artists and writers to its enchanting streets for generations. We'll drive on to our hotel in Maiori where we spend the next two nights.

## DAY 7 Excursion to historic Paestum to explore the temples

Today we drive to the unique archaeological site of Paestum for a guided tour. Founded by the Greeks in the 6th century BC and then colonised by the Romans, this once important city lay undisturbed amongst verdant forest until its rediscovery in the 18th century. Dedicated to the goddess Hera, the site contains some of the best-preserved Doric temples in Europe. The impressive remains are set against a backdrop of flowers and trees, creating a spectacular setting in which to explore the Temple of Neptune and the Basilica of Hera. During our visit to this UNESCO World Heritage Site, you will also have time to explore the excellent museum which houses famous tomb paintings. Following our visit we return to Maiori where the rest of the afternoon is free for you to relax. Maiori has the longest stretch on beach on the Amalfi coastline, and due to this, it has been a popular seaside holiday destination since Roman times. The main attractions in the town are the Collegiate Church of Santa Maria a Mare, with its brightly painted dome, and the 15th century Castle of San Nicola de Thoro-Plano. Maiori is also an area known for its delicious pastries, so we'd recommend a visit to the Salvatore De Riso's shop to sample a sweet treat or two. You might choose to venture slightly further afield and take a local bus to nearby Minori, which is home to the abandoned ruins of the ancient Roman villa of Marittima Romana.

## Preparing for your Trip

### Climate

#### Italy

April/May and October/November are pleasantly warm. June/September are the hottest months. Showers are common in Autumn.

### Clothing

July and August are the hottest months and lightweight cotton clothing is best. During spring and autumn temperatures can be lower or drop during the evenings and there is also a stronger possibility of rain. You'll need your swimming costume and light rainwear may be needed at any time of year. A warm fleece/jacket is recommended for cooler evenings and nights and layers for if you decide to climb Mount Vesuvius where the temperatures are lower.

### Equipment

A water bottle, sunhat and high factor sunscreen are all essential, and a torch is useful in case of power cuts or emergencies. Most importantly don't forget your camera.

### Footwear

Comfortable walking shoes for exploring (historical sites can be uneven underfoot) and trainers or sandals for relaxing.
