DAY 1 Overnight flight

DAY 2 Rio de Janeiro

Arrive in Rio de Janeiro and discover the capital's boutiques, boulevards and beaches such as Ipanema and Copacabana. Sunset in Rio is a spectacular time as the city's residents, the Cariocas, head for the beaches while the mountains cast long shadows under a pink and golden sky.

DAY 3 Corcovado Mountains and Sugar Loaf Mountain

Today you explore Tijuca Forest Park, the largest urban forest in the world. Enjoy spectacular views of the city and hike up Corcovado Mountain to Christ the Redeemer. Take a walking tour through the historic streets, ride a cable car up Sugar Loaf Mountain and visit the botanical gardens.

DAY 4 Rio de Janeiro

Today is free for you to relax on the beautiful beaches of Rio de Janeiro or explore the city at your leisure.

DAY 5 Iguazu Falls

Fly to Iguazu Falls and cross the border into Brazil for panoramic views over the Devil's Gorge. Iguazu Falls is 275 individual falls cascading down from a height of 70 m. On the Brazilian side, you will get great panoramic views of the falls from trails and viewing balconies running around them.

DAY 6 Visit the Argentinian side of the falls

Walk along trails under the pounding waters of the Argentinian side of the falls, among jungle surroundings. You will walk on upper and lower trails to get different perspectives of the falls, and an up-close look at the Devil's Gorge.

DAY 7 Fly to the Pantanal


Fly from Iguazu to Cuiaba and transfer to your lodge in the heart of the Pantanal.

DAY 8 Safari in the Pantanal

The Pantanal's rivers, tree canopies and wetlands are home to hundreds of species of birds, thousands of brightly-coloured butterflies and some of the world's most intriguing mammals. Depending on the lodge you are staying in, you'll have several activities to choose from - try canoeing, horse riding, photo safaris, piranha fishing, alligator spotting or nature walks.

DAY 9 Pantanal Biosphere Reserve

Your second day in the Pantanal can be spent enjoying one of the activities available from your lodge. Try a nature walk in search of capybara, anaconda, peccary, giant otter, metre-long macaws and ocelots, if your very lucky, maybe even a jaguar!

DAY 10 Fly to Salvador

Transfer to Cuiaba airport for your flight to Salvador. Salvador is the capital of the Bahia region, and was also the first colonial city in Brazil. Renowned for its Portuguese colonial architecture Salvador has now been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY 11 Salvador

Today you will visit some of the highlights of the city. You'll be captivated by Salvador's extraordinary architecture and historical presence. Starting at Barra's lighthouse and fort, the tour continues through the squares and narrow streets to Pelourinho, the heart of the city. Some of the highpoints along the way include the popular Fonte Nova football stadium, a stop at the Mercado Modelo craft market and the Nossa Senhora do Rosario dos Pretos Church.

Food & Drink

ATM Availability: Available in Major towns. Always have some cash as back-up as they are not always reliable

Credit Card Acceptance: Credit cards are useful and can be used in many places, but may be subject to a 10% service charge

Travellers Cheques: Travellers Cheques can be awkward or expensive to change

Local Currency: Real.

Recommended Currency for Exchange: Carry all your funds in US cash NOT Sterling or Travellers Cheques which are more difficult to exchange. We recommend to take a minimum of US\$400-\$500 of your total spending money in cash, in mixed denominations. Notes should be in good condition otherwise they might be difficult to exchange.

Where to Exchange: Your Tour Leader will advise you on arrival.

Joining your Trip

Flight Information

You are able to book this tour on a 'land only' basis or as a 'flight inclusive' package. Your flight inclusive package will be fully protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) ATOL protection scheme.

Booking a land only package with Explore

Customers who have chosen to book on the 'Land Only' arrangements of our tour, please ensure that you have checked your tour specific 'Joining Instructions' prior to booking your own travel arrangements. Joining Tour Abroad

Customers booked on the 'Land Only' arrangements will now receive a Free Transfer, provided you arrive and depart on the tour only itinerary start and end dates. The transfers will be from the Explore designated airport or train station to the joining point of your tour, and then back from the ending point to the designated airport or train station. The exception to this rule is customers who are booked on a tour where the joining and ending point is at the designated airport or train station.

Free transfers are not available for Self-Guided, Tailormade or Tours for Churches customers.

If you are not eligible for the Free Transfer then you will need to make your own way through to the joining and ending point. On a majority of our tours Explore will be able to provide a private transfer at an additional cost. Please ask for a quote at the time of booking.

Booking a flight inclusive package with Explore

Important Information

Travel Insurance

It is a condition of booking with Explore that you have adequate valid travel insurance. It is your responsibility to arrange appropriate travel insurance and ensure you have read and understood the full terms and conditions of your travel insurance policy to ensure that you are covered for all activities you intend to undertake whilst on the tour, including all optional activities. Your Insurance Policy must fully cover you for medical expenses and emergency repatriation to your home country. Please ensure your policy includes medical emergency helicopter evacuation in the event of illness or injury and covers the entire duration of your holiday. If you are trekking at altitude please ensure that there is no upper altitude limit which may limit or exclude cover for your trip. Medical and repatriation insurance cover is not mandatory for UK residents who are travelling on trips within the United Kingdom.

Please note that some countries require proof of parental consent when travelling overseas with under 18s. Please check requirements with the relevant embassy or consular office well in advance of travel if this applies to your party.

Vaccinations & Protection

Brazil

Nothing compulsory, we recommend protection against malaria, typhoid, tetanus, polio and hepatitis A. Please consult your travel clinic for the latest advice on Malaria, Dengue and Zika Virus. Please take preventative measures to avoid mosquito bites - these include mosquito repellent as well as long trousers and long sleeve shirts to cover up when necessary. We recommend protection against yellow fever. There have been very few cases reported, but local authorities do recommend travellers get immunised against yellow fever. Preparing for your Trip

Climate

Brazil

As befits such a large landmass, there are several distinct regional variations. Rio's and Paraty's average maximum is 25°C May-October, the rains falling December to March. On this tour, rain should be expected at some time - and if travelling in July and August, temperatures will be cool at night in the area around Iguazu and Curitiba.

Luggage allowance on trip:

Unfortunately it does occasionally happen that luggage does not always reach its destination on the same flight as its owner, or possibly it may be damaged in transit. If you are unlucky enough for this to occur, it is important that you file a PIR (Property Irregularity Report) with the airline before leaving the airport. This is essential when you come to make a claim either against the airline or from your travel insurance company

You can book your Explore holiday with confidence, as all monies paid to us for your trip are fully protected. Explore is a fully bonded tour operator licensed by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and by ABTOT.

The air holiday packages (Tours including flights) that we advertise are ATOL protected, since we hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence granted by the Civil Aviation Authority. Our ATOL number is ATOL 2595. In addition, As a member of the Association of Bonded Travel Organisers Trust Limited (ABTOT), Explore has provided a bond to meet the requirements of the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992. Please note that packages booked outside the UK are only protected when purchased directly with Explore.

Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

For Self-Guided holidays and Private Journeys simply choose your date of travel and let us know so we can confirm all ground services.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% non-refundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services. If your travel starts within 60 days of booking, full payment will be required at the time of booking
