Our journey takes us through the greatest of Norway's fjords and along the most spectacular of train lines including a trip on the famous Flam Railway and the scenic Raumabanen Railway. We explore nature at its most impressive, in this land carved by glaciers, on this comprehensive journey through Norway's Western Fjords.

Travelling largely by local transport we discover the magnificent landscapes of the western Norwegian fjords as we travel from Oslo to Bergen. We also take a cruise on the stunning Geiranger Fjord and take a ride of the famed Flam Railway along the way.

DAY 1 Join tour in Oslo

Welcome to Oslo, the biggest city in Norway. Oslo has been Norway's capital for more than 700 years. The history of the city dates back to the middle ages, and the earliest buildings still standing today are over 1000 years old. As well as the pretty Scandic architecture Oslo is in a wonderfully scenic location at the end of the Oslo fjords, and surrounded by pristine forest. On arrival at Oslo Airport today, our Explore Leader will meet you to hand over your public shuttle bus ticket which will get you to our hotel in the city. The journey is quick and easy, paid for in advance



and our Explore Leader will ensure you know where to get off the bus. A group introduction will take place at our hotel later on this evening, so that everyone can get to know each other and also to whet your appetite about what's to come on the trip.

DAY 2 Using a 24-hour Oslo Pass we visit the Bygdoy Peninsula and Viking Ship Museum

Today we start our holiday with a full day in Oslo. We will visit Bygdoy peninsula by ferry to see the Viking Ship Museum. We have a 24 hour Oslo card which allows entrance to many of the cities attractions so you can pick and choose those that interest you. After lunch you may chose to visit the Folk Museum or Munch Museum.

DAY 3 Travel on the scenic Raumabanen Railway and Trolls Road to Geiranger

After breakfast we depart Oslo to Lillehammer by train. Lillehammer was the host town of the 1994 Winter Olympics. The journey heads north through the Romsdalen Valley and continue from Dombas on the spectacular Raumabanen Railway along the Rauma River all the way to Andalsnes. The railway is 114 km long and travels over the Kylling Bridge. From here continue your journey on our bus towards Geiranger. The journey takes us along the Troll Road, one of Norway's best known tourist attractions. The road has 11 turns and the highest point is 858 meters above sea level. Dramatic, exciting and the ultimate nature experience - this is the best way to describe it. A short ferry crossing will take us to the Eagle Road and to Geiranger.

DAY 4 Hike above Geiranger Fjord to admire the view before a cruise on the waters

We start today with a mini cruise on the Geiranger fjord and get closer to the magnificent waterfalls on our way to Skafela. We then take a moderate four hour hike via Skagefla farmstead. This is a great way to stretch our legs and enjoy some of Norway's beautiful scenery as we walk up slopes and along cliff ridges and enjoying a stop for lunch along the way. Our hike takes us back to Geiranger before we continue our journey to Alesund by public bus. Please note that a good level of fitness is needed for the hike today, as some sections of the walk are steep in order to get to the best view points. Good walking shoes/hiking boots will be needed as it can be slippery underfoot.

DAY 5 Travel along the beautiful West Norwegian fjords

Today is all about the journey, as we travel through Norway's picturesque fjords with noticeable scenery changes the further south we go. We will experience the West Norwegian coastal landscape on our way from Alesund to Skei by private bus to Briksdal Glacier. Part of the grand Jostedal Glacier, this arm of the glacier cuts it way down the valley before melting into the river below. We have some time to admire our stunning surroundings before we continue on to the small village of Skei. Located on the shores of Lake Jolstravatn and with mountains on the other side; Skei is surrounded by nature at its most spectacular.

DAY 6 Ride the famed Flam Railway; orientation walk of Bergen

Early this morning we will leave Skei by public bus to Balestrand where we board the boat to Flam. We'll travel through the beautiful Sognefjorden into Aurlandsfjorden surrounded by green hills, rocky cliff edges and pretty waterside houses. We then catch the Flam Railway to Myrdal on the Hardangavidda plateau. On the 20 kilometre train ride we experience some of the most dramatic and magnificent Norwegian nature. We can see rivers that cut through deep ravines, waterfalls that plunge from the steep cliffs of the snow-capped mountain slopes, as well as mountain farms clinging on to steep slopes. The Flam Railway is one of the world's steepest railway lines on normal gauge tracks. Nearly 80% of the route is on a 55% gradient, with twisting tunnels that spiral in and out of the

mountain. At Myrdal we connect with the train to Bergen. On arrival we have an orientation walk through old city centre, including the fish market at Torget and the historic Bryggen Waterfront (UNESCO World Heritage Site).

DAY 7 Full day in Bergen to explore with a 24-hour Bergen Card

Today we can enjoy a full free day in Bergen to explore. Bergen offers many attractions and sights including the Hanseatic harbour Bryggen, Floibanen Funicular, Troidhaugen, the Fish and Flower market, Bergen Aquarium and Gamle Bergen (Old Bergen Open Air Museum) all of which can be visited. We have included a 24-hour Bergen Card which gives you entrance or a reduced rate to visit many of the cities main attractions and museums.

Flight Information

Joining Tour Abroad

The transfers will be from the Explore designated airport or train station to the joining point of your tour, and then back from the ending point to the designated airport or train station. The exception to this rule is customers who are booked on a tour where the joining and ending point is at the designated airport or train station.

Free transfers are not available for Self-Guided, Tailormade or Tours for Churches customers.

If you are not eligible for the Free Transfer then you will need to make your own way through to the joining and ending point. On a majority of our tours Explore will be able to provide a private transfer at an additional cost. Please ask for a quote at the time of booking.

Climate

Norway

Seasonal Climate Despite the northern latitudes the climate in Norway is not extreme, due to the affects of the North Atlantic Drift. Between May and September is the best time to visit this region, with summer temperatures reaching the high teens and rain a regular feature year round along the coast. North of the Arctic Circle the sun does not set between the middle of May and the end of July, so you can expect to encounter the midnight sun during this period.

Clothing

Light and medium clothes are needed, including a warm sweater and windproof outer garment, as the weather can vary considerably on a daily basis. Raingear is essential at any time. Evenings, nights and early mornings can be cold at the beginning and end of the season. Other items that may prove useful are gloves, a warm hat and lightweight thermals.

Equipment

Suncream, hat and sunglasses. Binoculars could also be useful for the Fjord cruise. A waterproof jacket is also recommended.

Footwear

Comfortable walking shoes, trainers and sandals.

Luggage: On Tour

One main piece and a daysac. Remember, you are expected to carry your own luggage – so don't overload yourself.

Please note that packages booked outside the UK are only protected when purchased directly with Explore.

Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

For Self-Guided holidays and Private Journeys simply choose your date of travel and let us know so we can confirm all ground services.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% non-refundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services. If your travel starts within 60 days of booking, full payment will be required at the time of booking
