Our journey also takes us to the beautiful islands in the Gulf of Thailand, where we discover hidden coves on Koh Phangan Island and relax on picture perfect tropical beaches of Koh Samui.

You will travel using a mixture of overnight train, airplane, public ferries, local taxi and private buses giving you a real flavour of being in the destination, and a real sense of adventure!

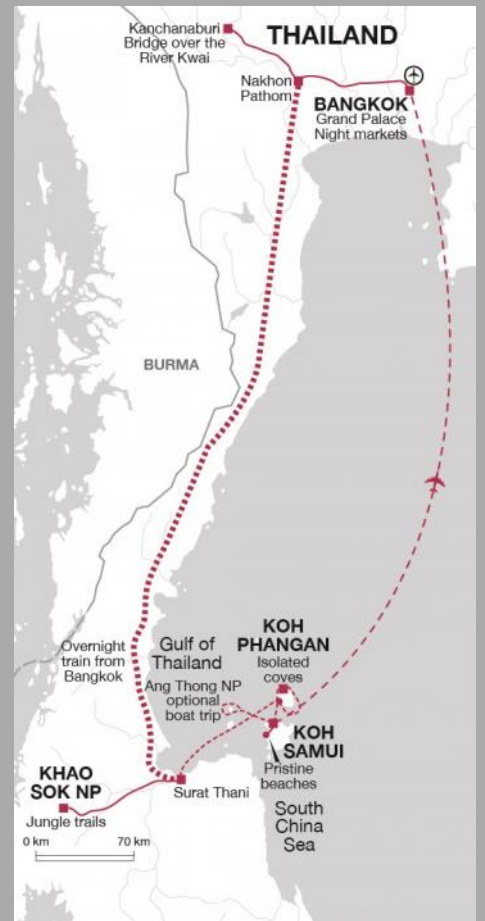
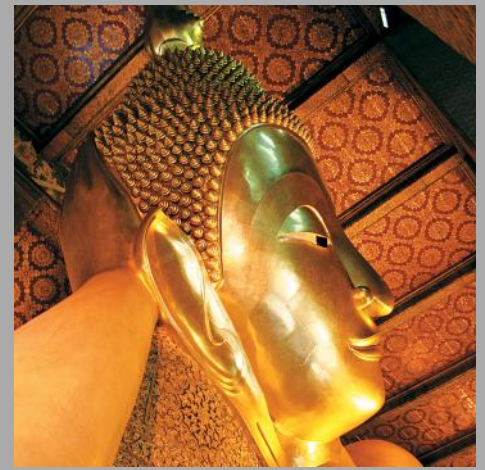

Tour itinerary notes

While our intention is to adhere to the day-by-day itinerary as printed below, a degree of flexibility is built in. Overnight stops may vary from those suggested.

DAY 1 Join tour in Bangkok

Arrive in Bangkok and check-in at the hotel. The rest of the day is free. You may choose to take an optional cruise along the city's Klongs (canals) in a traditional longtail boat. This is the ideal way to explore Bangkok's network of meandering waterways that branch off from the main channel of the Chao Phraya River. The excursion will also include visits to the Royal Barge Museum and the iconic Wat Arun, the Temple of the Dawn, which was built to represent the towering slopes of Mount Meru, the home to the gods of Khmer mythology.

DAY 2 Drive to Kanchanaburi; visit Bridge over River Kwai; take sleeper train south to Surat Thani

We make an early start today to head to Kanchanaburi, located 128 kilometres west of Bangkok. We visit the world-famous bridge over the River Kwai and Allied War Cemetery before continuing onto the Hellfire Pass. The building of the bridge and the Death Railway, as it has become known, is one of the most infamous episodes of the Second World War. The Japanese built the railway to link Siam and Burma (Myanmar) using Prisoners of War between June 1942 and October 1943. After, we transfer to Nakhon Pathom for dinner before catching our overnight sleeper train which will take us through the night to Surat Thani.

DAY 3 Arrive in Surat Thani; drive to Khao Sok National Park; afternoon jungle walk

On arrival in Surat Thani this morning we will drive to our riverside jungle lodge in Khao Sok National Park. Covering an area of some 65,000 sq km the park is one of the oldest and most bio-diverse jungles in South East Asia, boasting a lush rainforest that is older than those of either the Amazon or Central Africa. This afternoon we take a walk with our park ranger along jungle trails, and learn something about the flora and fauna of the park. The park is home to a rich diversity of wildlife including elephant, tiger and Malaysian sun bear and with some 180 species of birds it is a haven for keen birdwatchers and novices alike, although of course wildlife viewings can never be guaranteed.

DAY 4 In Khao Sok National Park; free day in the jungle with canoeing and swimming options

Today has been left free. There is the option to hire canoes and take them on the river. Alternatively if a more relaxing day is preferable then it is possible to swim in the river near the lodge, or simply relax and enjoy the idyllic jungle surroundings with the noises of the rainforest all around and the sight of monkeys descending from the surrounding canopy to drink at the waters edge. This evening we aim to take a night safari walk.

DAY 5 Ferry to Koh Phangan Island; free afternoon

Driving back to Surat Thani this morning we catch a ferry to Koh Phangan and on arrival taxis, which are converted pick-up trucks known locally songthaew, will take us to our hotel on a quiet bay on the north western side of the island away from Koh Phangan's notorious full moon parties. The afternoon is free to relax and enjoy the picturesque white palm fringed beaches and warm tropical waters of the Gulf of Thailand.

DAY 6 From Koh Phangan, boat trip around the island

Today we explore this beautiful area by traditional long tail boats as we make our way around the island, stopping at secluded bays where we can swim and snorkel as well as find waterfalls that can only be reached by boat. Some of the waterfalls were once considered so beautiful that they attracted the attentions of the Thai kings of old and a number of them can be found with the carved insignia of these regal visitors etched into boulders and rocks. Snorkelling equipment and life jackets are provided and a simple lunch of rice and fruit is included.

DAY 7 Ferry to Koh Samui Island; free afternoon with optional cooking class

This morning we take a ferry to the neighbouring island of Koh Samui. The largest of the islands in the Samui Archipelago, Koh Samui is the most developed and it is a distinctive mix of quiet palm fringed beaches, backpacker resorts and coconut plantations. This afternoon is free and you may wish to partake in an optional Thai cookery course, where an expert cook will teach even the most inexperienced the fundamentals of Thai cookery so that the fabulous cuisine can be recreated on your return home. Should anyone feel the need for shopping and nightlife, local songthaew taxis ply the route to the shops, bars and clubs of Chaweng, and the town of Na Thon is just a 20 minute walk along the beach from where we are based.

DAY 8 On Koh Samui; free day with option to take a boat trip into Ang Thong National Marine Park

Today is left free for you to enjoy exploring and indulging at your leisure. Koh Samui is slightly different from many of the other islands in southern Thailand, owing in some part to the influence of the Hainan islanders who first settled the island some 150 years ago. The Chinese influence is still visible in some of the buildings in Na Thon and some descendants of the original settlers still live in the area. While relaxing on a tranquil beach might be order of the day there is also the opportunity to take an optional boat trip to Ang Thong National Marine Park, inspiration for the book 'The Beach'. Snorkelling equipment is provided and there are ample opportunities to swim in this stunning protected area.

DAY 9 Fly to Bangkok; afternoon visit to Grand Palace and see reclining Buddha at Wat Pho

This morning we fly back to Bangkok. In the afternoon we will see Bangkok's major sights including the Grand Palace, probably the most impressive of all the historical monuments in Bangkok with its collection of palace buildings, golden stupas, Wats (temples) and decorative statues. The most impressive of the Wats is Wat Phra Kaeo, otherwise known as The Temple of the Emerald Buddha. We will also visit Wat Pho, one of the largest Wats in Bangkok and famous for its 46 metre gold-plated reclining Buddha. The evening may be best spent at a night market bartering for souvenirs or on a roof terrace bar with views of the bright lights of the city at night.

Credit Card Acceptance: Major stores and restaurants.

Travellers Cheques: Can be exchanged at banks and exchange offices throughout the tour although rates may not be as favourable.

Local Currency: Thai Baht

Recommended Currency for Exchange: We recommend that you bring your money in GBP or US\$.

Where to Exchange: Most major towns and on the islands - your Tour Leader will advise you on arrival.

Flight Information

You are able to book this tour on a 'land only' basis or as a 'flight inclusive' package. Your flight inclusive package will be fully protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) ATOL protection scheme.

Booking a land only package with Explore

Joining Tour Abroad

Customers booked on the 'Land Only' arrangements will now receive a Free Transfer, provided you arrive and depart on the tour only itinerary start and end dates. The transfers will be from the Explore designated airport or train station to the joining point of your tour, and then back from the ending point to the designated airport or train station. The exception to this rule is customers who are booked on a tour where the joining and ending point is at the designated airport or train station.

Free transfers are not available for Self-Guided, Tailormade or Tours for Churches customers.

If you are not eligible for the Free Transfer then you will need to make your own way through to the joining and ending point. On a majority of our tours Explore will be able to provide a private transfer at an additional cost. Please ask for a quote at the time of booking.

Visa Information

Thailand: Visas are not required by UK, Australian, New Zealand, US and Canadian citizens for a stay of less than 30 days. All passports must have at least 6 months validity remaining on entry to Thailand. Other nationalities should consult their local embassy or consular office.

If you do require assistance in obtaining a visa then you may consider applying through Explore's recommended visa service in the UK, Travcour. See www.travcour.com to download the relevant visa application for your trip, if applicable (UK citizens only), along with details of how to apply for your visa through Travcour. The Team at Travcour will be happy to answer specific questions relating to visa applications, please call them directly on 0208 5431846.

Vaccinations & Protection

Thailand

Nothing compulsory, we recommend protection against malaria, typhoid, tetanus, diphtheria, polio and infectious hepatitis. Although not compulsory, travellers may also wish to immunise themselves against Japanese encephalitis. Consult your travel clinic for latest

advice on Malaria and Zika Virus. Please take preventative measures to avoid mosquito bites - these include mosquito repellent as well as long trousers and long sleeve shirts to cover up when necessary. The above is not an exhaustive list. Preparing for your Trip

Climate

Thailand

Generally hot with high humidity. There is some rainfall from April to September with most days being hot (around 33 Degrees) and a light breeze on the islands. If it does rain, it will be more of a heavy tropical downpour that lasts a few hours. Additional information and climate charts can be accessed at <http://www.explore.co.uk/weather>.

Clothing

Pack for essentially for hot weather. Bear in mind that the region is tropical (humid) and that days can be very hot. Lightweight rainwear or an umbrella is advisable all year. Casual clothes are the most practical (something with long sleeves, and long trousers for evenings), and tight fitting garments should be avoided. Laundry facilities are available on the islands. A swimming costume is a must. Shorts and open backed sandals are not permitted in the Grand Palace.

Equipment

A small torch, insect repellent, water bottle. Bring a beach towel and high factor sunscreen. If you intend to do much snorkelling we recommend you bring your own mask and snorkel, as local equipment is not always top quality. A disposable waterproof camera can be useful whilst snorkelling. Any qualified divers should remember to bring logbooks and certification with them if intending to dive.

Footwear

Comfortable shoes and sandals. Flip-flops are useful when hopping on and off boats.

Luggage: On Tour

One main piece of baggage and daypack. Remember you are expected to carry your own luggage so don't overload yourself.
