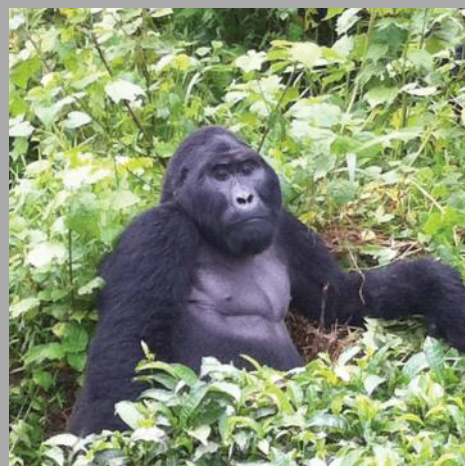
While our intention is to adhere to the day-by-day itinerary as printed below, a degree of flexibility is built in. Overnight stops may vary from those suggested.

DAY 1 to 2 Fly to Uganda

Depart the UK on a flight to Entebbe, on arrival transfer to Kampala.

Why Book this tour?


Uganda is sunny most of the year with temperatures usually remaining comfortable & rarely exceeding 30 degrees. Just like its African neighbours, Uganda follows a similar pattern with two wet seasons during the year. The main rainy season falls between late March and May with rain often lasting days, thus making travel difficult. The light rain season is during November when it generally lasts only an hour or two each day leaving conditions revitalised and refreshed.

DAY 3 Journey to Kibale Forest


After breakfast transfer northwest to Fort Portal, resting in the shadow of the fabled Mountains of the Moon this town is most famous for the many tea plantations. After lunch continue to Kibale National Park.

DAY 4 Chimp tracking

Kibale Forest is reputable of having the greatest variety and highest concentration of primates in East Africa. Enjoy a guided nature walk in the tropical rainforest in search of the wild chimpanzee, red-tailed monkey, black-and-white colobus monkey and many others. After lunch drive to Queen Elizabeth National Park. This evening enjoy a romantic private dinner on the Captains table, Captain's Table, a one-of-a-kind floating pontoon on Lake Nyamusingire.

DAY 5 Queen Elizabeth National Park


An early morning game drive takes you in search of lions, elephants and buffaloes around the park. In the afternoon take a boat cruise along the Kazinga Channel, a natural channel between Lake Edward and Lake George. Thanks to the abundant birdlife, herds of elephants, buffaloes and hippos this will definitely be one of the highlights of your safari!

DAY 6 Free morning, transfer to Bwindi

This morning has been left free, you may choose to relax at the hotel or go for a hike through the river valley in the Kyambura Wildlife Reserve in search of chimpanzees. In the afternoon continue to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park, home of the endangered mountain gorillas.

DAY 7 Gorilla tracking

Spend a day in and around the park. Head into the depths of the rainforest with expert guides as you track the magnificent mountain gorilla. Observing these magnificent primates in their natural habitat is such a memorable experience. Back at your lodge enjoy a complementary one hour full body massage.

DAY 8 Transfer to Lake Mbuoro

Depart the impenetrable forest and head to Lake Mbuoro National Park, is renowned for its rich birdlife and beautiful lakes; you have a game drive en route to your lodge. After dinner enjoy a night safari game drive, this is a great time to spot hippos out of the water and if you're lucky, leopards!

DAY 9 Lake Mbuoro National Park

This morning take a walking safari in search of zebra, warthog, buffalo, impala and possibly Africa's largest antelope, the eland. This afternoon transfer back to Entebbe with time for some souvenir shopping.

DAY 10 to 12 Zanzibar

Depart Entebbe for Zanzibar, where you can relax by the pool, swim in turquoise waters and enjoy evening walks on palm-fringed sandy beaches. Optional excursion include snorkelling, dhow cruises or kayaking can also be arranged.

ATM Availability: Major towns and cities will have ATMs available.

Credit Card Acceptance: Credit cards are generally not accepted.

Travellers Cheques: Take some to act as reserve funds.

Local Currency: Tanzanian Shilling.

Recommended Currency for Exchange: US Dollars are preferable. Please be aware that any notes issued before 2006 will not be accepted

Where to Exchange: Banks or 'Forex' offices only in main towns/cities. Your Tour Leader will advise you on arrival.

ATM Availability: Very limited and unreliable.

Credit Card Acceptance: Unreliable

Travellers Cheques: We do not recommend travellers cheques

Local Currency: Ugandan Shilling.

Recommended Currency for Exchange: You should take the majority of your spending money in US Dollars cash some of which to change into Ugandan Shillings. Please be aware that notes issued pre- 2006, or are not the "Big Face" kind, are not normally accepted in East Africa at all. Take mixed denomination bills in good condition and note that higher Ugandan Shilling rates are available for larger (\$50- \$100) US Dollar bills. Dirty and torn US Dollar notes are NOT accepted at all in Uganda. GBP Sterling is easily exchanged in Kampala only.

Joining your Tour

Flight Information

You are able to book this tour on a 'land only' basis or as a 'flight inclusive' package. Your flight inclusive package will be fully protected by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) ATOL protection scheme.

Booking a land only package with Explore

Customers who have chosen to book on the 'Land Only' arrangements of our tour, please ensure that you have checked your tour specific 'Joining Instructions' prior to booking your own travel arrangements. Joining Tour Abroad

Customers booked on the 'Land Only' arrangements will now receive a Free Transfer, provided you arrive and depart on the tour only itinerary start and end dates. The transfers will be from the Explore designated airport or train station to the joining point of your tour, and then back from the ending point to the designated airport or train station. The exception to this rule is customers who are booked on a tour where the joining and ending point is at the designated airport or train station.

If you are not eligible for the Free Transfer then you will need to make your own way through to the joining and ending point. On a majority of our tours Explore will be able to provide a private transfer at an additional cost. Please ask for a quote at the time of booking.

Important Information

Travel Insurance

It is a condition of joining any of our tours that you must have valid travel insurance. It must indicate that you have cover for (at least) medical expenses and emergency repatriation in the event of illness or injury. Medical and repatriation insurance cover is not mandatory for UK residents who are travelling in England and Scotland. We also strongly recommend your policy includes curtailment, personal effects and cancellation protection as all deposits paid are non-refundable. You will also need to ensure your travel policy covers you for all activities you intend to do whilst on tour.

We are delighted to include FREE travel insurance **for all qualifying customers** who book an Explore trip from 01 January 2015.

Vaccinations & Protection

We strongly recommend protection against malaria, hepatitis A, tetanus, typhoid, polio and yellow fever. Please note you are required to produce a valid yellow fever certificate on arrival in Tanzania if you have spent 10 hours or more transiting through an endemic country. Consult your travel clinic for latest advice on different prophylaxis available against malaria. Travellers may also wish to take immunisation against meningococcal meningitis. The above is not an exhaustive list. Preparing for your Tour

Climate

Tanzania

The climate is tropical but varies greatly with altitude. Coastal areas are hot and humid, the central plateau dry and arid. It can be cold at night, particularly in June & July and at altitude. Generally the long rains arrive April/May and the short rains Nov/early Dec. Although this pattern can be completely erratic. Uganda

Although conditions are tropical, hot and humid in the centre and west, the rest of Uganda has a pleasant and comfortable climate. The dry season is generally from December to early March and June to the end of August/early September. Temperature can vary from around 28°C during the day to 12°C in the evening. High mountain areas become much cooler at night. Most of Uganda experiences a double rainy season. Rainfall is moderate, only exceeding 1250mm a year in the higher areas. But it may rain at any time of the year, particularly in equatorial rainforest such as Bwindi. Lake Victoria influences the local weather patterns considerably and ensures the surrounding region is wetter than elsewhere. The air holiday packages (Tours including flights) that we advertise are ATOL protected, since we hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence granted by the Civil Aviation Authority. Our ATOL number is ATOL 2595. In addition, As a member of the Association of Bonded Travel Organisers Trust Limited (ABTOT), Explore has provided a bond to meet the requirements of the Package Travel, Package Holidays and Package Tours Regulations 1992. Please note that packages booked outside the UK are only protected when purchased directly with Explore.

Reserving your place

To reserve your place on this tour you will need to check availability on the Explore website or through our dedicated call centre based in the UK where you can. Our tours can fill up quickly so you are advised to book as early as possible. If your chosen date is 'Available' or 'Guaranteed' we will be able to provisionally hold you a space for up to 48 hours.

For Self-Guided holidays and Private Journeys simply choose your date of travel and let us know so we can confirm all ground services.

The easiest way to confirm your booking is through our website. When you are ready to book, we normally require a 10% non-refundable deposit, but for some holidays this may be more to cover such items as permit fees, internal flights or other non-refundable services.
